From I-95 south, take exit 157 (Newport). Turn left onto Route 2. Continue on Route 2 for 24 miles to Skowhegan. Turn right onto Route 201 (Madison Avenue). Continue for 1.2 miles, then take a slight right onto East Madison Road and continue for 0.6 miles.
